\*Opening retained profit + profit – dividend = closing balance retained profit (0 + 100,000 – 0 = 100,000)

**Practice Problem B**

- 1 Accrual profit = total sales – total expenses  
 = \$750,000 + 260,000 – 580,000 – 240,000  
 = \$190,000
- 2 Sales revenue = 2,000 x \$8  
 = \$16,000  
 Cost of goods sold = 2,000 x \$5  
 = \$10,000

**Practice Problem C**

- Shareholders' equity = Assets – Liabilities  
 = (Property, Plant and Equipment \$1,500,000 + Accounts  
 Receivable  
 \$400,000 + Cash \$100,000 + Inventory \$500,000)  
 – (Bank loan \$250,000 + Wages Payable \$90,000)  
 = \$2,500,000 – 340,000  
 = \$2,160,000
